

Lesson Plan For PPE Class on Tuesday, 04/20/2021 - DRAFT

- I. Opening of Session - Announcements and Reminders (9:30 - 9:36)
- II. Q&A (9:36 - 9:45+/-) Depends whether and what questions students have.
- III. Breakout-Discussion Session # 8: (9:45+/- 10:15) (*Learning Goals: Reflective Analysis, Critical Thinking, and Group Collaboration & Decision Making.*)

“Considering all that we have covered this semester, what single idea or Golden Nugget do you feel will have a lasting influence on how you understand the connections of people, places, and environment?” Consider if and how this answer might be involved or touched upon in your Essay.

Process:

- Step 1. Before we breakout into Zoom Meeting Rooms, individually take 2 minutes to reflect about this semester and this PPE Course.
- Step 2. Put your individual response in the Zoom Chat.
- Step 3. **As a group** in your Breakout Zoom Room, decide what the top 3 answers are (you do not need to rank the top 3 your group agrees upon). Reporters make a list and put the group’s decision about the top three in the Zoom Chat. Reporters, hang on to the list.
- Step 4. Return to Main Room and Reporters make their oral report regarding their group’s top three. (5 groups & 5 reports)
- Step 5. Brief discussion by the entire class. Were any of the top three repeated? If so, which one’s. (Do you want to take a straw poll as a class regarding the top three? Use the Zoom Reactions yes/no buttons to tally votes for each nominee.)

- V. Continuation Think Tank Discussion of your topics. (10:15+/- to 10:45)

Share what you have learned or any changes you have made or are making. Conceptual or research tips or problems you have encountered. Ask your colleagues questions or ask for advice. You can also use this time to actually work on your Essay — research and/or writing. You can pose questions to the instructors.

- Close Zoom Breakout Meeting Rooms (10:45)

Note: If you leave the Breakout Room to ask a question in the Main Room, we can return you to your Breakout Room.
